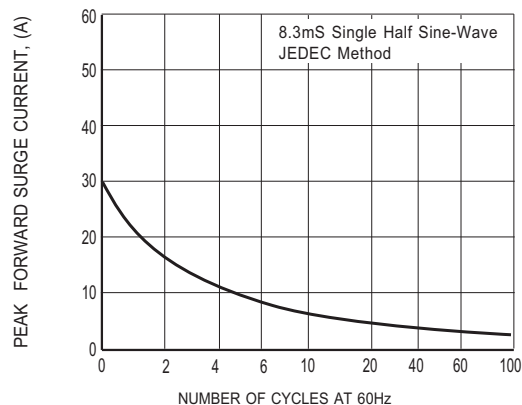


FIG.1 MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE FORWARD SURGE CURRENT

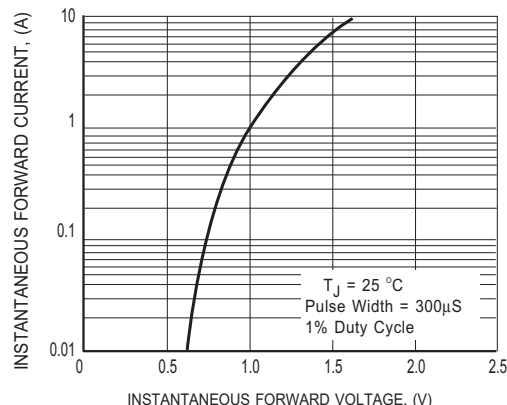


FIG.2 MAXIMUM INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

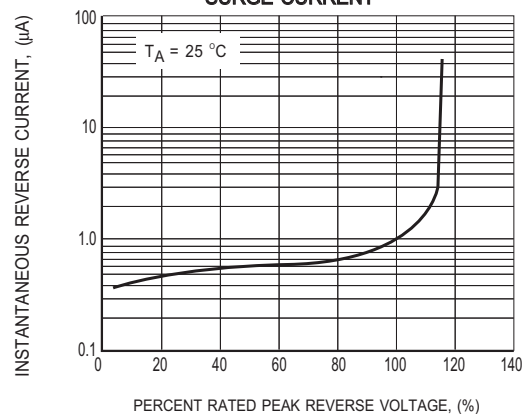


FIG.3 MAXIMUM REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS

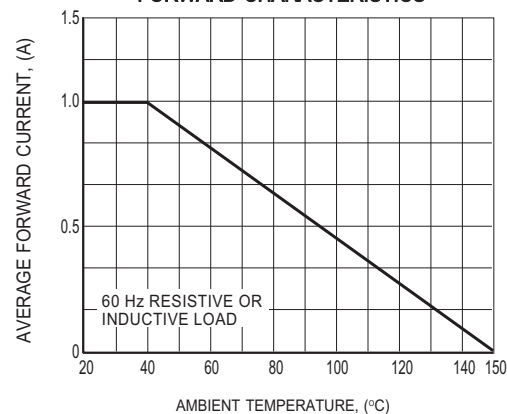


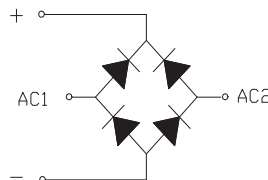
FIG.4 TYPICAL FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE



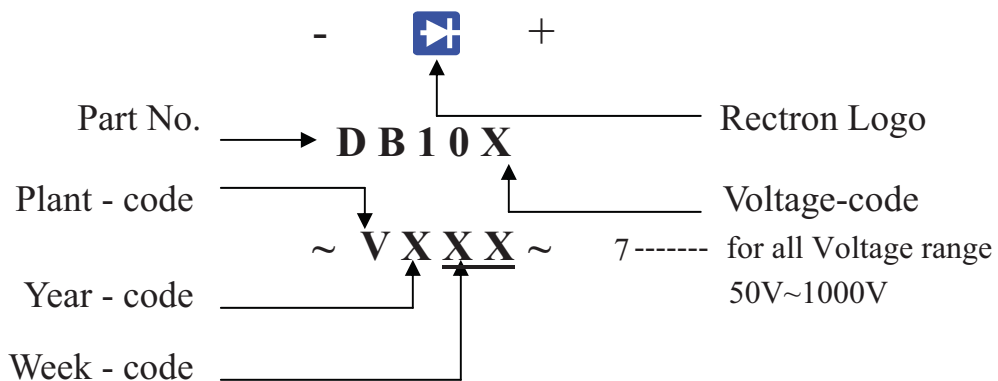
