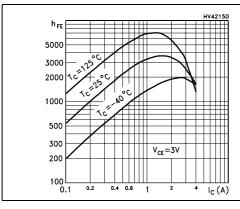

Figure 3. DC current gain (PNP)






Figure 4. DC current gain (NPN)




Figure 5. DC current gain (PNP)





Figure 6. Collector-emitter saturation voltage (NPN)

Collector-emitter saturation voltage (PNP)

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



Figure 10. Base-emitter voltage (NPN)








Figure 12. Resistive load switching time Figure 13. Resistive load switching time (NPN, on) (PNP, on)







Figure 14. Resistive load switching time Figure 15. Resistive load switching time (NPN, off) (PNP, off)




Figure 16. Resistive load switching test circuit


