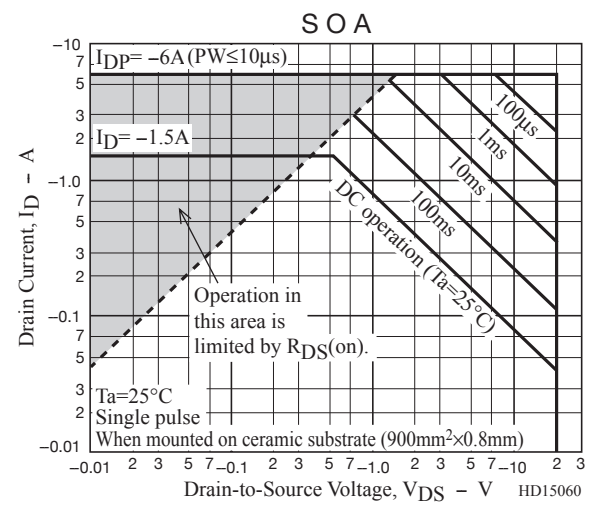
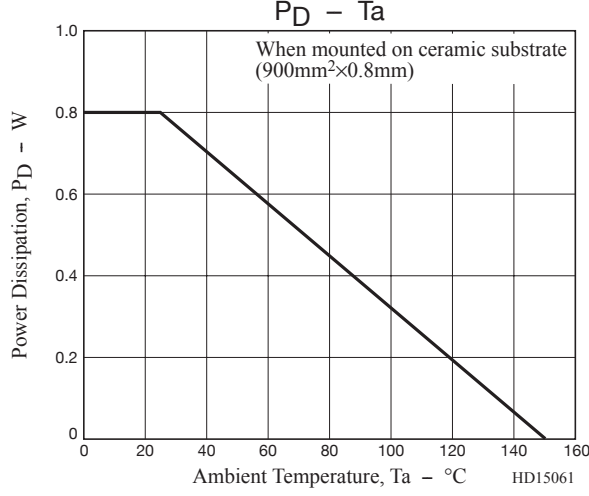
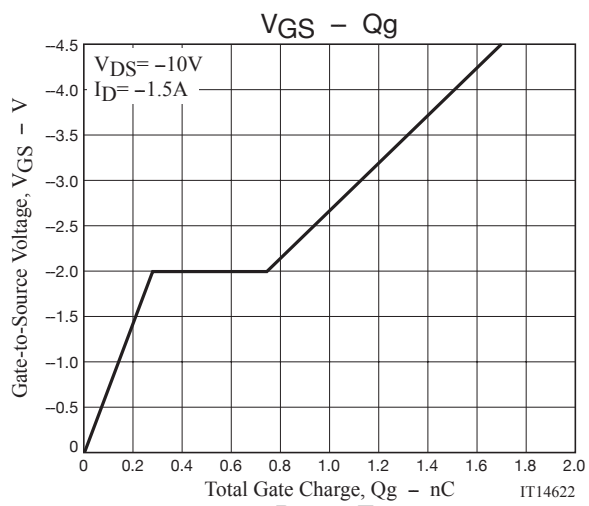
Switching Time Test Circuit

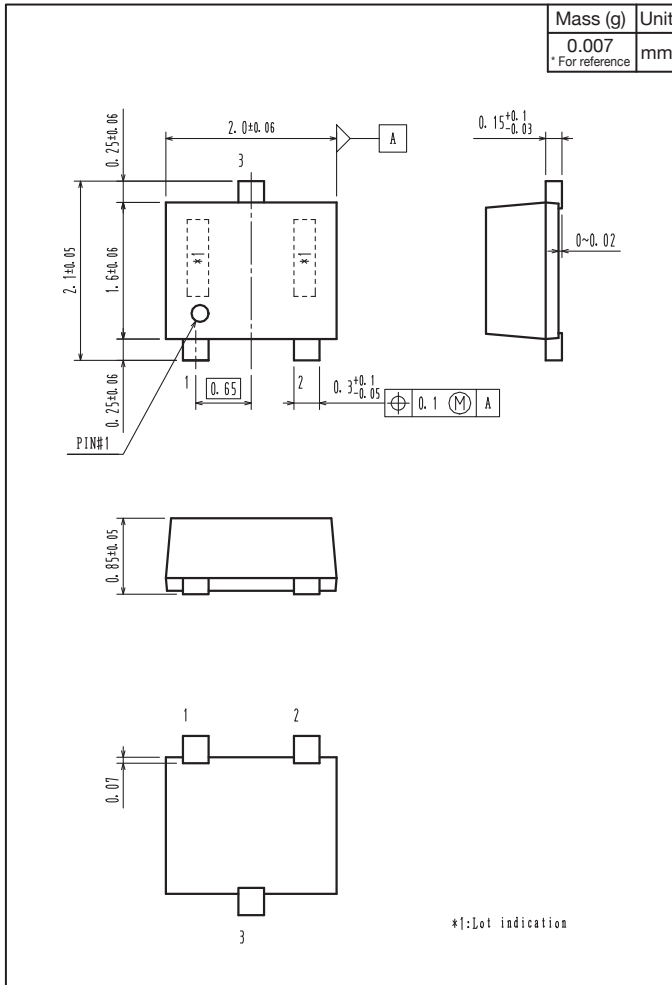

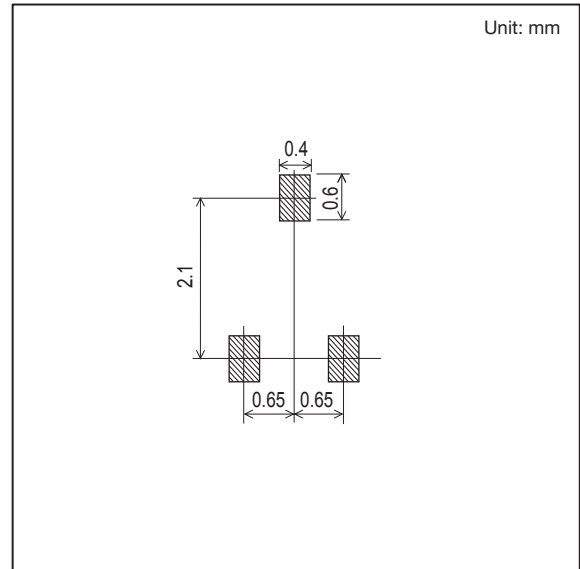
