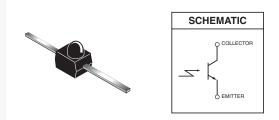

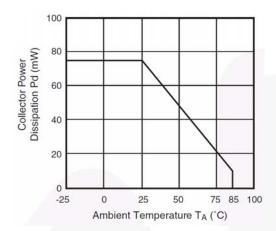


Figure 1. Collector Power Dissipation vs. Ambient Temperature

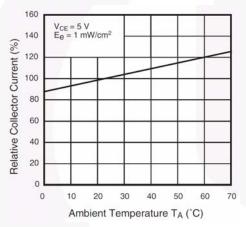


Figure 3. Relative Collector Current vs. Ambient Temperature

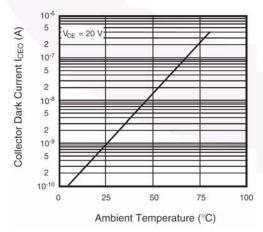


Figure 5. Collector Dark Current vs. Ambient Temperature

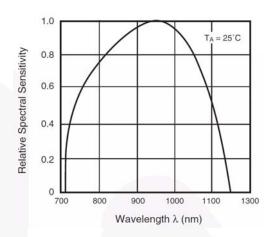


Figure 2. Spectral Sensitivity

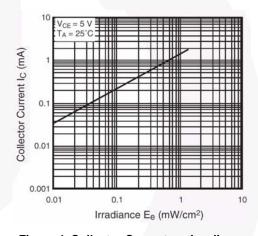


Figure 4. Collector Current vs. Irradiance

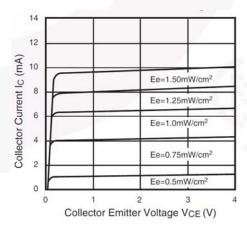
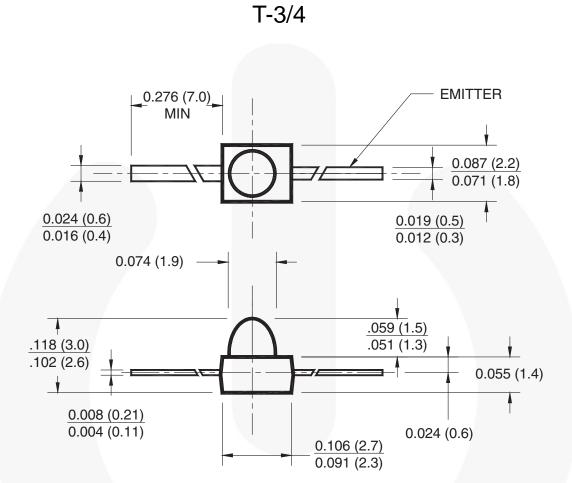


Figure 6. Collector Current vs. Collector Emitter Voltage

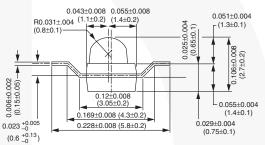
## **Gull-wing Lead Configuration**



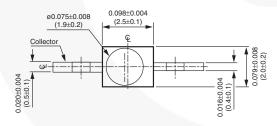


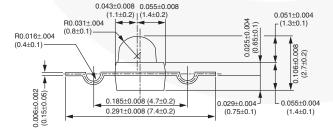
## **Z-Bend Lead Configuration**
