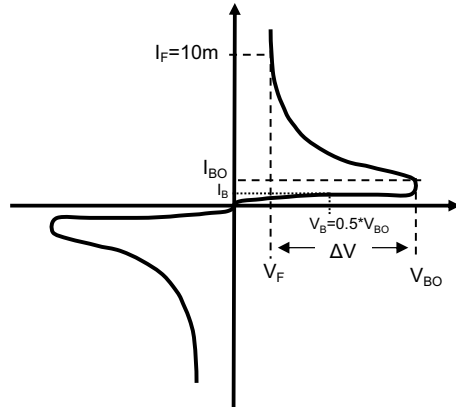


Typical Performance Characteristics

Diagram 1 : Test circuit

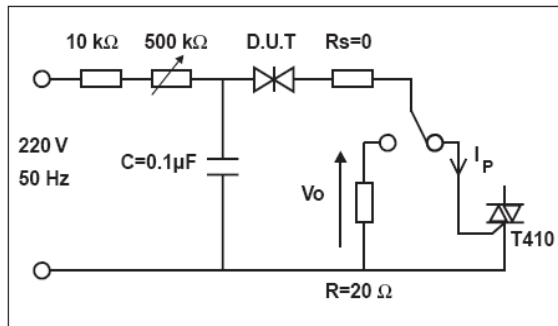


Figure 2. Relative Variation of VBO versus Junction Temperature

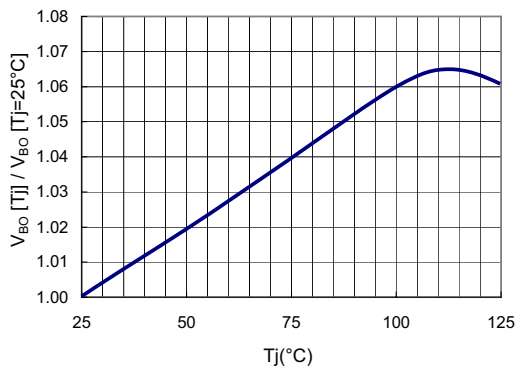
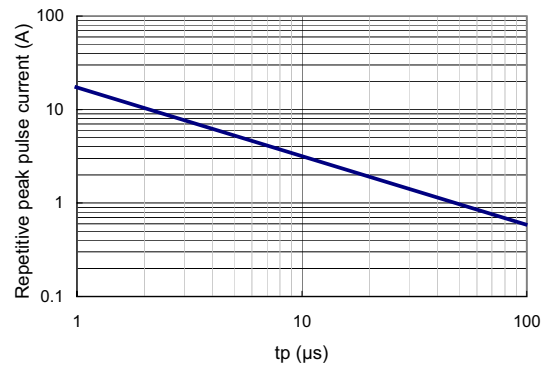
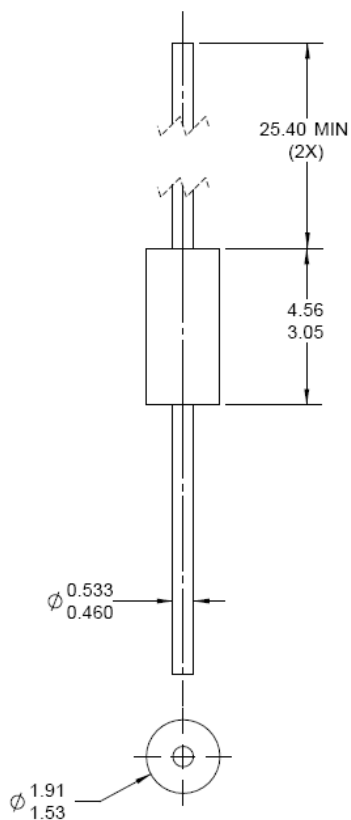


Figure 3. Repetitive Peak Pulse Current versus Pulse Duration (maximum values)
