


FIGURE 2-1: Output Characteristics.




FIGURE 2-2: Transconductance vs. Drain Current.




FIGURE 2-3: Maximum Rated Safe Operating Area.




FIGURE 2-4: Saturation Characteristics.




FIGURE 2-5: Power Dissipation vs. Case Temperature.




FIGURE 2-6: Thermal Response Characteristics.





FIGURE 2-7: B
Temperature.






FIGURE 2-8: Transfer Characteristics.




FIGURE 2-9: Capacitance vs. Drain-to-Source Voltage.




FIGURE 2-10: Current.

On-Resistance vs. Drain




FIGURE 2-11: Temperature.




FIGURE 2-12: Characteristics.





FIGURE 4-1: Switching Waveforms and Test Circuit.




