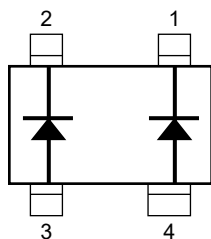
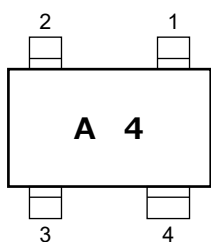


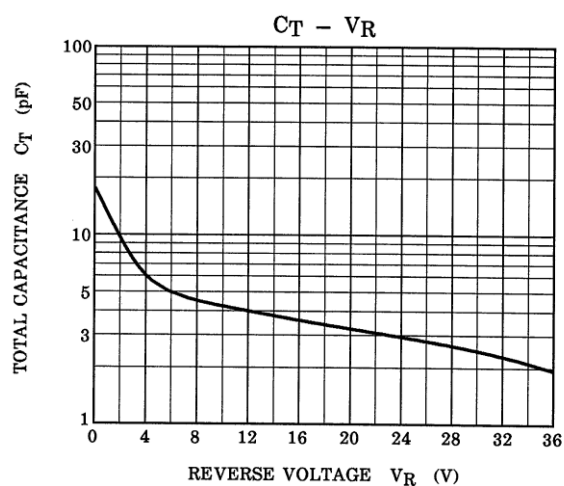
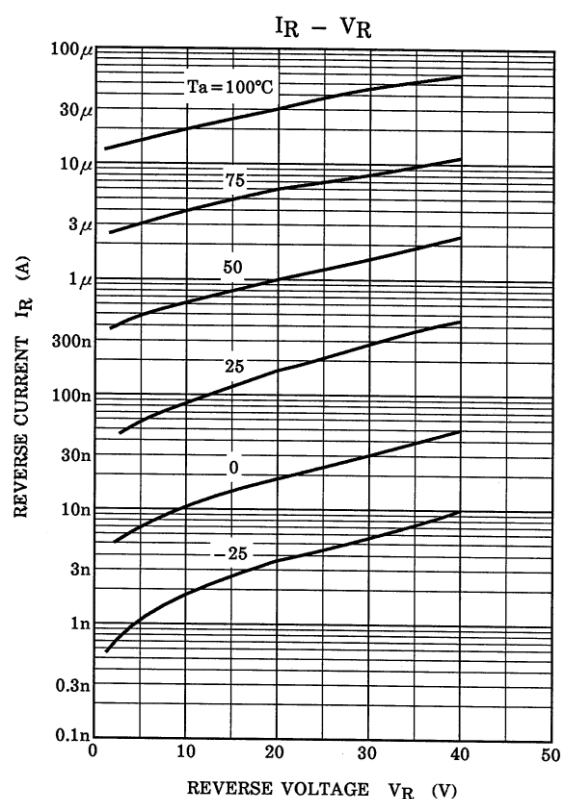
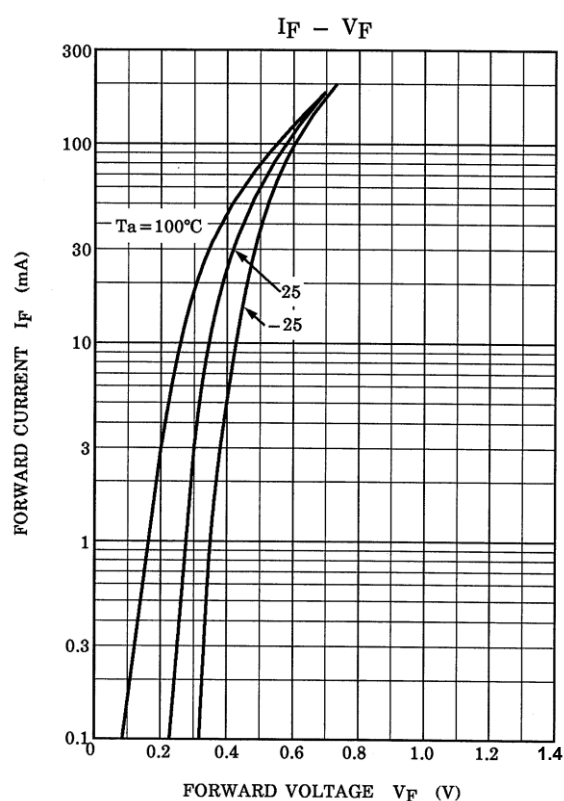
Equivalent circuit (Top view)
