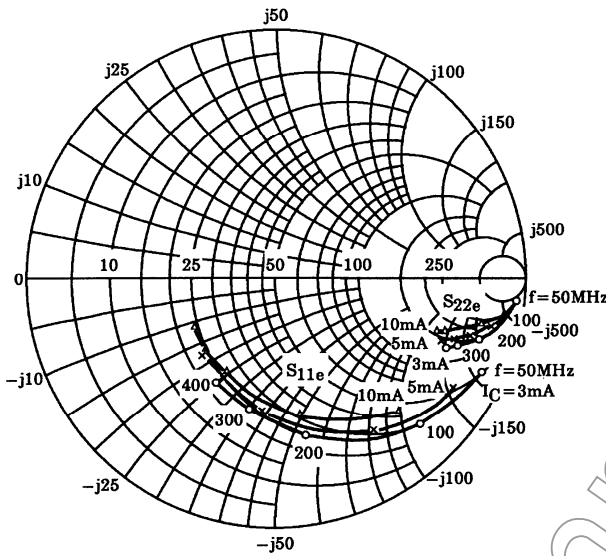
Figure 1 200 MHz G_{ce} , NF Test Circuit

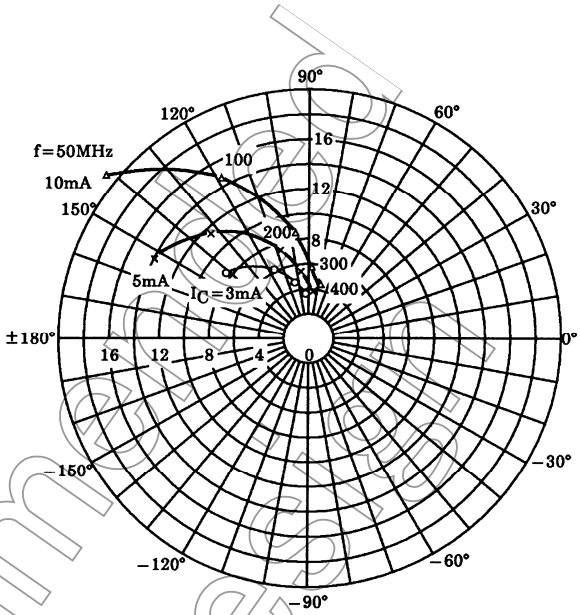




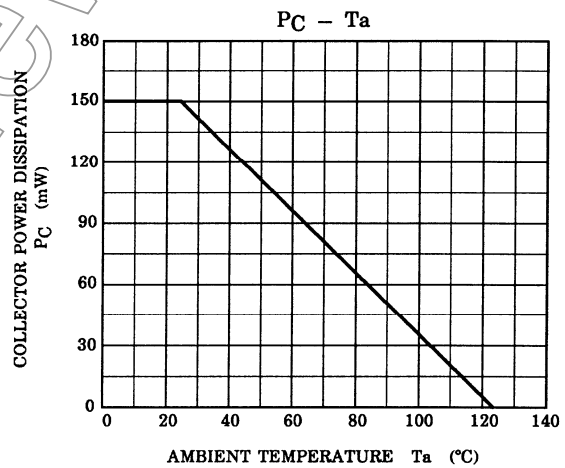
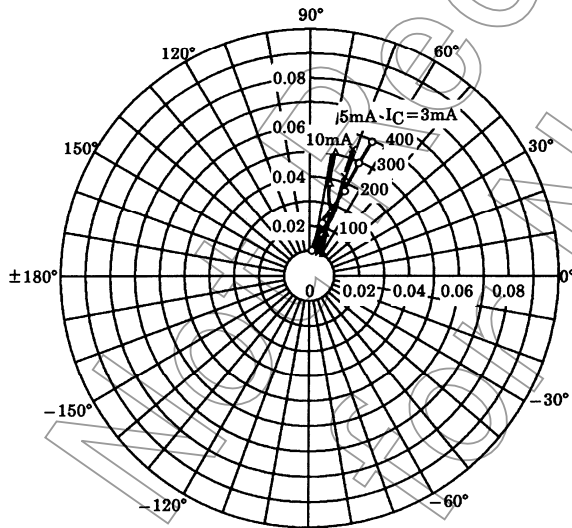
